LETMEASKUAQUESTION angled down to set the pace, rated well around the turn then held clear under strong urging. BROAD BUT NICE prompted the issue four and five wide, could not gain on the winner while second best late. YOU ROCK pressed the pace outside the winner, lacked a closing bid. FLUVANNA stalked the pace four wide down the backstretch, dropped to the inside on the turn but was no threat in the drive. GATEWAY LADY forced the issue three wide, angled to the rail around the turn, lacked a late response. DIXIE DINA off a step slow, saved ground, swung out three wide around the turn, lacked the needed rally. HI TECH TOY five wide along the backstretch, was no factor. JOYOUS JOYCE saved ground to no avail.
